RARE CHAMPAGNE

When a regular old bottle of bubbly won't do!

Ullyse Collin Les Maillons Blanc de Noirs - "Insanely beautiful...Beguiling, totally fascinating," according to Robert Parker's Wine Advocate, which gave this fab Champagne 95pts stating "Collin crafts beguiling, totally fascinating Champagnes from his tiny facility in the sleepy town of Congy. The wines are fermented and aged in barrel (with some lees stirring) and bottled without fining or filtration." A Kensington Wine Market exclusive, too! **\$110**

Marie Courtin Allegiance 2013 - One of the most hauntingly beautiful Champagnes you'll ever try. This exclusive, biodynamic, Grower Champagne from the Cotes des Bar is artfully produced by Dominique Moreau, on the estate she has named for her grandmother. Only 30 bottles are coming to Alberta this year. Exclusively to KWM! **\$130**

Champagne Agrapart Aizoise NV - Robert Parker scored this semi-exclusive Champagne from Coteaux d'Avize at 94pts, saying: "Extra Brut Blanc de Blancs Grand Cru l'Avizoise offers an absolutely clear, fresh, discreetly aromatic and elegant bouquet of ripe apples, ultra-ripe pears, dates, limes, chalk dust, iodine and some hints of licorice." Produced from Champagne harvested from 50+ year old vines, the wine has a firm mineral structure and an almost Burgundian character. **\$206**

Champagne Laherte Blanc de Blancs Nature 3L NV - Jeroboams - or Double Magnums - are four times the fun of a regular 750mL bottle of Champagne. This 100% Chardonnay Champagne is produced from only the best vineyard parcels in Epernay and the Côte des Blancs. This Brut Nature is a modern style of Champagne, matured 6 months on lees, zero dosage, and vinified with minimal intervention. A staff favourite. **\$420** or **\$72** for a 750ml

Krug Brut Rose NV - Wine Spectator scores this crisp, creamy Champagne at 96pts. Stylistically consistent with the rest of the Krug range, this dry Champagne has just the faintest hint of pink. Blended from 4-6 different vintages it is elegant, refined and sophisticated bubbly! **\$425**

Moet Dom Perignon P3 1985 - Unlike the standard release, Dom's P2 and P3 expressions are matured on cork for extended periods of time. The three expressions, or Plenitudes (hence the P2 and P3), show the evolution of Dom Champagne as it matures. The P3 is the pinnacle of refinement and sophistication. **\$2200**

This champagne is elegant and enticing, with a bright nose full of exciting citrus and floral notes, leading to a palate full of complexity and character. A Phenomenal Champagne for the price point, need I say more? **\$60**

• **Andrew – Coopers Choice 1982 Golden Grain 35 Year** This is an extremely rare and very complex blended grain Scotch whisky. Amazing value for a cask strength 35 year old. Only 18 bottles are coming to KWM, and they won't last! Know anyone born in 1982? **\$250**

• **Bryan – Dalwhinnie Moonambel Shiraz** Hailing from the Australian Pyrenees, the Dalwhinnie (hollow in the hills) Moonambel Shiraz is comprised of grapes from the most remote and highest of the districts vineyard. It is insupposably fragrant: violets, incense and eucalyptus drift from the glass. Salty and savory reflections of Sichuan pepper and black olives inundate the palate. **\$80**

• **Chris – Kay Brothers Amery Mataro 2008** A black cherry and dark chocolate beauty, this spicy Mataro from the oldest winery in McLaren Vale is smooth as silk. Only about 36 bottles left, so don't dawdle! **\$37**

• **Curt – G&M Distillery Label Ardmore 1996** One of my favorite whiskies of the last year. This '96 is a truly old school style of malt. Soft, almost tropical fruit notes meet a style of subtle and smoky peatiness that speaks more to whiskies distilled in the seventies than more contemporary times. Harkens back to some of the softer, more nuanced Springbanks that won my heart long ago. Dangerously drinkable. **\$200**

• **Dave – Marie Courtin Resonance** This is an amazing Champagne from an even more amazing woman. Doing something she loves and making killer biodynamic wine. Crisp, refreshing, and complex. If you want fantastic champagne this deserves to be on the top of your list. Make any day a champagne day! **\$82**

• **Don – Lamadrid Cabernet Sauvignon** Argentina may be known for Malbec, but you have to try this Cabernet. Wow! A wine full dark cassis fruit, beautifully balanced and with a long smooth finish. I thought it would be impossible to find a wine of this quality at this price. So glad I was wrong! **\$22**

• **Evan – Kilchoman 10yr KWM Cask** This is currently my favourite Islay malt, and the best Kilchoman I have ever personally tasted. We started with 212 bottles, but there are only a few cases left and it will likely be gone by October or November. Good thing we have already selected our next cask! **\$200**

• **Grant – KJ Wines Patria 2015** Looking for a spectacular California Cab for a special evening or gift, look no further. This wine has it all, gorgeous dark fruit nose, loads of sumptuous rich fruit on the palate and a finish that goes for ever. Open early and drink late or let it rest for a few years. Gorgeous! **\$140**

• **Keith – Tomatin 1999 KWM Cask** This one earns its bragging rights. At 18 years of age, 5 of them in a Pedro Ximenez Sherry Butt, it is big and jammy on the nose and mouth. Over-ripe strawberry for days, zesty marmalade and honey with vanilla beans and dark chocolate. So delicious you'll want to spread this one on toast! **\$150**

• **Marty – Cooper's Choice Ardmore 2001** 16 Year It doesn't have to be from Islay to be smoky. This cask strength offering has very nice citrus and vanilla notes complemented by the slightly ashy peat character, all at a naturally concentrated cask strength to grab your palate but not abuse it. **\$145**

• **Shawn – Gouden Carolus Van de Keizer Whisky Infused** Het Anker's Quad infused with their own single malt whisky. Rich and sweet with dried fruits, and hints of spirit, leather, chocolate and oaky vanilla. **\$33.99**

• **La Trappe Oak Aged Quad** A Belgian Quad aged in French Brandy barrels. Rich malty body with prominent notes of oak, dried fruit and boozy brandy. Warm baking spice and fruity esters with a semi-sweet finish. **\$16.99 / 375ml bottle**

• **Alley Kat Pumpkin Pie** The Edmonton tradition continues! As always, this beer is super spicy complete with full pumpkin flavour and pie-crusty malts! Comforting and delicious! **\$17.79 / 6-pack bottles**

• **Cascade Sang Rouge:** A blend of several barrel-aged red ales. Massively tart with big notes of tart berries, raspberry and cranberry. **\$39.09 / 740ml bottle**

• **Founders Canadian Breakfast Stout:** A big, bad imperial stout with coffee and chocolate, aged in a bourbon barrel that once held maple syrup. It's somehow even better than it sounds. **\$8.29 / 350ml bottle**

Brora 34 Year Distilled in 1982, the year before the distillery closed, the whisky was matured in refill Ex-Bourbon Hogsheads and bottled at 51.9%. **\$2200**

Brora 38 Year Bottled at 48.6% after maturing in refill American and European oak. This 1977 vintage Brora is a beauty, from a distillery which is becoming increasingly rare and expensive with every passing year! **\$2200**

Caol Ila 30 Year Bottled in 2014, this is an exceptional whisky, and reasonably priced by international standards. Creamy & tropical with bright soft smoke. **\$770** (special)

Convalmore 32 Year Only the 2nd official bottling of Convalmore ever to come to Canada, this 32 year old has been getting some rave reviews. **\$1650**

Duncan Taylor Tantalus Bunnahabhain 1968 Cask 701 Whiskies in the nearly 50 year old range are getting harder and harder to come by. We jumped at this one because the reviews were good. Only 2 bottles left! **\$2200**

Cadenhead Glen Moray 1992 KWM Cask Our first Cadenhead cask, and it is from our vintage... 1992 (year we opened)! Delicate, tropical and very fruity. **\$210**
