Congratulations Nancy Carten on Your Retirement!

In May of 2017 the Kensington Wine Market marked its 25th Birthday. We celebrated the anniversary over the course of the last year with a number of special bottlings and events. And we have another significant milestone to mark in 2018; the retirement of our founder Nancy Carten.

Nancy Carten opened the business as a specialty wine market with a couple of partners in May of 1992. Under her stewardship the business became not only a Calgary icon, but a respected international player in the wine and spirits business. Over those years the business was recognized too many times to recount as a leader in the industry, not just in Calgary, but internationally too. Nancy trained and mentored many sommeliers and other beer and spirits experts, giving them their first break in the industry, including, most notably, our current owner.

Nancy sold the business to a long time employee, Andrew Ferguson in 2015, and has been serving as mentor over the last three years. She cultivated and nurtured Andrew's interest in whisky and gave him the opportunity to build a career from what, for most, is a hobby. "I am incredibly indebted to Nancy for the opportunity she gave me, not just to follow my passion, but the even bigger honour of carrying forward her legacy. It goes without saying that I would not be where I am today without Nancy's mentorship and confidence."

Staff Picks

Abi – Ulysses Collin Les Maillons Blanc de Noirs - This is a champagne you need to get on board with. It's full of wonder, with elegance and minerality, but also with a touch of richness. Organically produced without fining or filtration. Perfect for any occasion. **\$109.99**

Andrew – Compass Box Kensington Wine Market 25th Anniversary – If this whisky doesn't convince you Blended Scotch Whisky is beautiful, nothing will. Layered, rich and peaty with a silky backbone. We were amused to see it selling for \$500CDN+ in European auctions! **\$160**

Bryan – Dumol Lia Viognier 2015 - This archetypal viognier is a favorite Kensington wine market exclusive. Expansive textures reticulate into myriads of sensations. Creamy orange blossom, racy ginger and almond paste are effortlessly refreshed with zesty grapefruit and a tangy slate-like minerality. **\$81.99**

Curt – Cadenhead Glen Moray 1992 KWM Cask - Quarter century old cask strength malts just don't seem to exist at this price point anymore. An incredibly clean cask bottled for our 25th anniversary. A great mix of soft fruits, firm oak and pristine cereal notes make this malt a no-brainer. **\$204.99**

Dave – Chateau Domeyne - I have always enjoyed this wine, and the current vintage does not disappoint. This lovely Red from Bordeaux France is full of body and vivacity. It is bold and punchy with lots of plum and dark berry fruits coming across along with some oak and earthy flavours. **\$40.99**

Don – Laherte Blancs de Blanc Nature - Spring is here and we should celebrate with this delicious Champagne! This limited Blancs de Blanc champagne is full of apple and tropical fruits, so balanced, so perfect, and an outstanding buy too. This KWM exclusive is the patio wine you want this spring! **\$67.99**

Evan – Wyoming Bourbon KWM Cask #2 - We loved our first single barrel so much that we almost immediately choose a second! Bottled at 53.3% ABV this wheated bourbon may come off as big and bold, but it is also dangerously drinkable and loaded with decadent spice. Move over Kentucky! **\$98**

Keith – Cadenhead Small Batch Glen Spey 2001 - On the nose: fresh hot buttered popcorn, and pokings of marzipan and maraschino cherry. Red liquorice drizzled with vanilla and warm brown sugar on the palate. It begins floral and herbal before settling into delicious vanilla custard on the finish. **\$119.99**

Shawn – Gouden Carolus Cuvee Van de Keizer Whisky Infused – Van De Keizer Blue label infused with Het Anker's own single malt whisky. Rich and sweet with dried fruits, hints of spirit, leather, chocolate and oaky vanilla. **\$33.99**

- Innis & Gunn Kindred Spirits:** A Scottish stout aged in Irish whiskey casks. It showcases a decadent profile of chocolate, coffee and vanilla with a hefty dose of oak. **\$6.19/330ml**
- Wild Rose High Harvest Hemp IPA:** A dank, tropical and silky IPA, done in the New England style. Big piney hops with big fruity tones all over. The fuller mouthfeel is pleasant, cloudy and goes down easy. **\$12.39/4 Pack**
- Railyard Stout:** Railyard brewing brings us one of the first Calgary-made canned nitro stouts. Silky and creamy with a lovely body and a hint of sweetness, not too roasty but just roasty enough! **\$17.39/4 Pack**
- Wild Rose Prairie Rumbler:** The rumbler is a big English strong ale aged in rum barrels. A noticeable sweetness gives way to slight barrel and big rum character that remains though until the end. **\$12.29/650ml**
- Banded Peak Plainsbreaker:** One of the best in the province! Hazy, silky and softly grainy base with oodles of hops giving huge tropical and citrus flavours. **\$16.39/4 Pack**
- Zero Issue Dystopia White IPA:** A bright and fruity IPA made even more aromatic and fruity with Hefe yeast. Note of pears, bananas, clove, and citrus. **\$16.19/4 Pack**
- Common Crown Ploughman:** A sturdy malt base with a good amount of wheat and hints of tropical hops layered overtop (but not too much). The aim here was for something easy drinking, and it is achieved nicely. **\$16.29/6 Pack**
- Ballast Point Coconut Victory at Sea:** Huge aromas of dried shaved coconut with enough chocolate to resemble a bounty bar. Medium to full-bodied with a pronounced bitterness that helps to cut through the sweetness near the end. **\$13.49/650ml**
